

# Scarf Bohême

## Material :

3 skeins of [Sari de Fonty](#).

48 wood pearls ovals (length 2cm)

Needles 12mm, a wool needle.

Of the a little bit thick cardboard.

A good pair of scissors.

## Used points:

Garter stitch

Fancy point:

Row 1 (right side): Knit

Row 2 (wrong side): Selvedge stitch, purl 1, \*Yarn over 1, P2 together\*, repeat from \* to \*, purl 1, knit 1.

Row 3 (right side): Selvedge stitch, knit 2, \* Yarn over 1, knit 2 together\*, repeat from \* to \*, knit 1.

Row 4 (wrong side): Selvedge stitch, purl 2, \* Yarn over 1 , P2 together \*, repeat from \* to \*, knit 1.

Row 5 (right side): Selvedge stitch, knit 1,\* Yarn over 1, knit 2 together\*, repeat from \* to \*, knit 2.

**Repeat rows from 2 to 5.**

Work:

Begin with fringes:

Make a template with your 25 cm cardboard, roll up your wool around way of obtaining 24 stalks of 50cm each.

With the needle with wool, thread two pearls on every stalk and then knot every extremity. Your fringes are ready.

The Scarf :

Cast on 22 stitches, do 4 rows of garter stitch then continue with the fancy point.

When you see that you arrive almost at the end of your wool, make of new 4 rows of garter stitch and cast off flexibly.

Bring in the threads and get away them to short.

Distribute fairly 12 fringes on each side of your scarf. (If need use a hook)
