# Hat Lori

One Size (hat size between 56 and 59 cm)

This model is the first in a series inspired by "Darkover" of Marion Zimmer Bradley, and directly referring to Volume 1: "Darkover Landfall". Every twist, every bend of this hat is rooted in the ups and downs through which the characters in this saga have to cross, on a planet whose colors would be those of this model.

### Material:

Circular Needles 5mm, cable needle, a stitch marker.

2 balls of Reggae Schoppel Wolle.

## Points and abbreviations:

st: stitch

k: knit

p: purl

m1p: make 1 and purl it

m1: make 1 and knit it

P2tog: Purl 2 stitches together

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

DC: central decrease: slip the first stitch knitwise, knit the 2 following stitches together, pass over the slip stitch.

R: round

\*...\* repeat from \* to \*

« Long cast tail »

#### make twists

#### Twists:

T 1, over 4 stitches: slip 2 st. to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle

T 2, over 6 stitches: slip 3 st. to cable needle and hold to back, k3, k3 from cable needle



T 3, over 6 stitches: slip 3 st. to cable needle and hold to front, k3, k3 from cable needle

T4, over 5 stitches: slip 2 st. to cable needle and hold to front, k2 and p1, k2 from cable needle

Gauge in stocking stitch, 10cm/10cm: 18stitches/24 rounds.

#### Work:

Cast on 80st in long cast tail, close the circle and put the stitch marker to indicate the start of the round then:

R1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7: \*k4, p1\*

R4 and 8: \*T 1, p1\*

R9: \*k4, m1p, p1\* (96st)

R10: \*k4, p2\*

R11: \*k4, p1, m1p, p1\* (112st)

R12: \*T 1, p3\*

R13: \*k4, p3\*

R14: \*k1, m1, k2, m1, k1, p3\* (144st)

R15: \*k6, p3\*

R16: \*k2, (m1, k1) x2, m1, k2, p3\* (192st)

R17: \*k9, p3\*

R18: \*T 2, k3, p3\*

R19, 20 and 21: \*k9, p3,

R22: \*k3, T3, p3\*

R23, 24, 25: \*k9, p3\*

R26: \*T2, k3, p3

R27, 28 and 29: \*k9, p3\*

R30: \*k3, T3, p3\*

R31, 32, 33: \*k9, p3\*

R34: \*T2, k3, P2tog, p1\* (176st)

R35 and 36: \*k9, p2\*

R37: \*k9, P2tog\* (160st)

R38: \*k3, T3, p1\*

R39: \*k9, p1\*

R40: \*k3, DC, k3, p1\* (128st)

R41 and 42: \*k7, p1\*

R43: \*k2, DC, k2, p1\* (96st)

R44 and 45: \* k5, p1\*

R46: \*T4, p1\*

R47, 48 and 49: \*k2, p1\*

R50: \* T4, p1\*

R51: \*k1, K2tog, k2, p1\* (80st)

R52 and 53: \*k4, p1\*

R54: \*K2tog, k2, p1\* (64st)

R55: \*k3, p1\*

R56: \*K2tog, k1, p1\* (48st)

R57: \*k2, p1\*

R58: \*K2tog, p1\* (32st)

R59: \*k1, p1\*

R60: \*K2tog\* (16st)

R61: \*k\*

Cut the remaining thread to 30 cm long, and then, using a tapestry needle, fix the top of the hat, bring in the threads and cut them short.
