

# Cowl and hat Shetland Colours.

Cowl : one size adult

Hat: Size M ( 56/57 cm of hat size) or L ( 58cm and more of hat size).

Material:

Main Color : 2 skeins of [The Croft Shetland Tweed](#) or [Shetland Colours Solid](#), WYS.

Minor Color :1 skein of [The Croft Shetland Tweed](#) or [Shetland Colours Solid](#), WYS.

Circular needles 4,5mm and 5,5mm.

Stitch marker, scissors, yarn needles.

Points and abbreviations:

C1: main color.

C2: minor color.

st : stitch

k: knit

p: purl

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together.

m1: make 1

\* ... \*: repeat the pattern between \* and \* as many times as necessary to finish the round.

Stocking stitch with circular needles: knit every stitches in every rounds.

Two-tone Ribs 2/2 with circular needles: repeat the following pattern to go to the end of the round: k2 in C1, p2 in C2. Repeat this round as many times as indicated.

Ribs 2/2 in solid color with circular needles: repeat the following pattern until the end of the round: k2, p2, in the color indicated. Repeat this round as many times as it is asked.

Jacquard: use the diagram, when you do not use a color, slip the thread behind the mesh and cross it with the thread used (to maintain it), every 2 or 3 stitches. Repeat the complete pattern of the diagram as necessary to arrive at the end of each round.

Gauge needles 5,5mm, stocking stitch: 20 stitches/20 rounds.

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## Cowl:

Cast on flexibly 120 stitches with needles 4,5mm in C1. Form the circle and start knitting in two-tone 2/2 ribs for 6 rounds. Take needles 5,5mm and knit 2 rounds in C1, then knit the full diagram. After round 51 of the diagram, knit 2 rounds in C1, take back needles 4,5mm and knit 6 rounds in two-tone ribs, and bind off all stitches flexibly in C1. Bring in the threads, cut them short, block your cowl if necessary.

## Hat:

Size L, with needles 4,5mm, cast on flexibly 104 stitches in C1, form the circle, put the stitch marker and knit 7cm in ribs 2/ with C1. Make an increase round: repeat the following pattern till the end of the round: \*k4, m1\*. At the end of this round, you have 130 stitches. Take needles 5,5mm, knit 1 round in C1, then knit with the diagram.

Size M, with needles 4,5mm, cast on flexibly 84 stitches in C1, form the circle, put the stitch marker and knit 6cm in ribs 2/ with C1. Make an increase round: repeat the following pattern \*k3, m1, k2, m1\* finish the round with k3, m1, k1. At the end of the round you have 117 sts. Take needles 5,5mm and knit a round in C1, then knit with the diagram.

## Decreases in C1 for both sizes:

Knit 1 round.

Decrease 1: \*k11, K2tog\* (120sts in size L, or 104sts in size M). Knit 2 rounds.

Decrease 2: \*k10, K2tog\* (110sts in size L, or 95sts in size M). Knit 2 rounds.

Decrease 3: \*k9, K2tog\* (100sts in size L, or 86sts in size M). Knit 1 round.

Decrease 4: \*k8, K2tog\* (90sts in size L, or 77sts in size M). Knit 1 round.

Decrease 5: \*k7, K2tog\* (80sts in size L, or 68sts in size M). Knit 1 round.

Decrease 6: \*k6, K2tog\* (70sts in size L, or 59sts in size M). Knit 1 round.

Decrease 7: \*k5, K2tog\* (60sts in size L, or 50sts in size M). Knit 1 round.

Decrease 8: \*k4, K2tog\* (50sts in size L, or 41sts in size M).

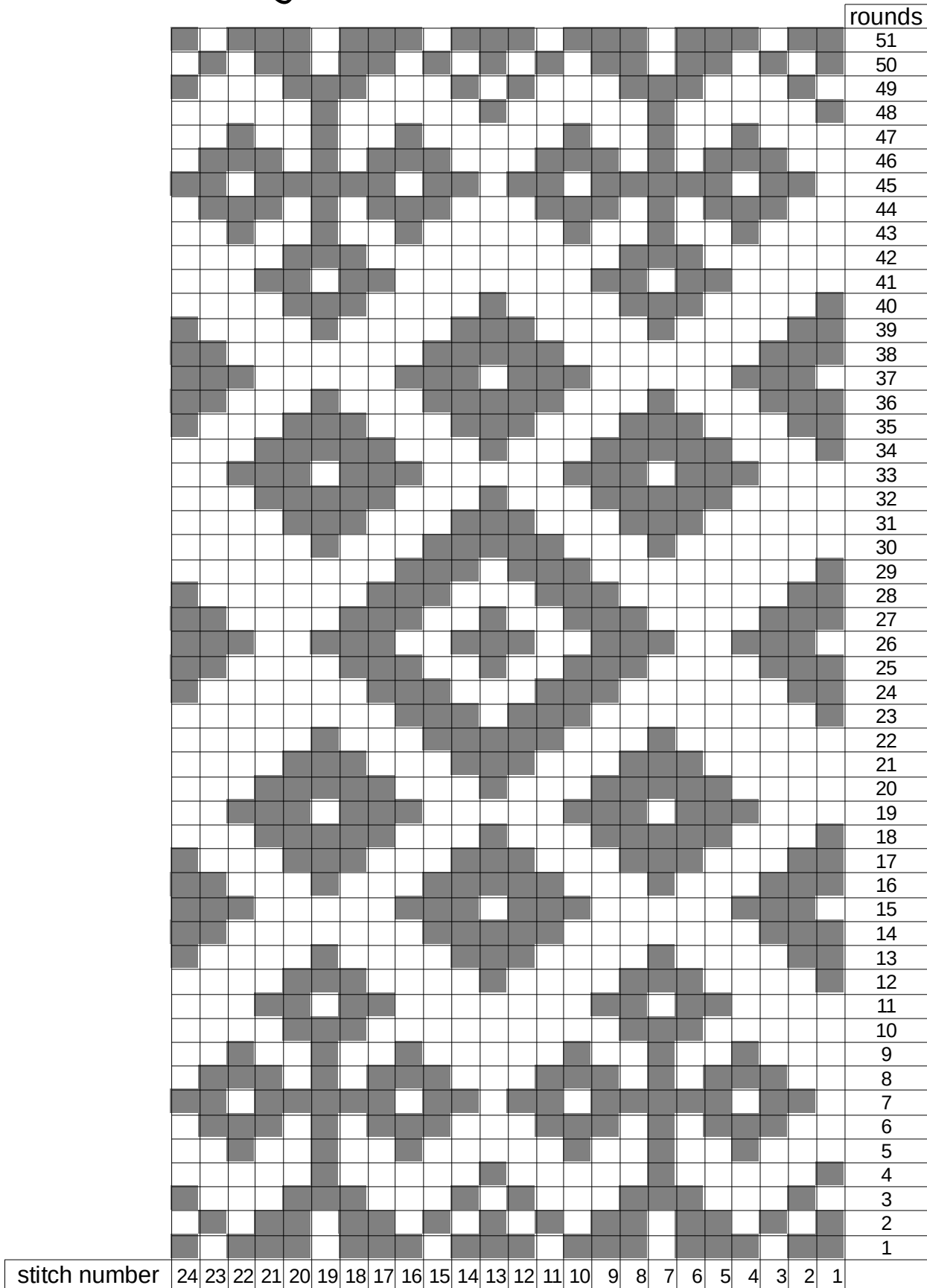
Decrease 9: \*k3, K2tog\* (40sts in size L, or 32sts in size M).

Decrease 10: \*k2, K2tog\* (30sts in size L, or 23sts in size M).

Decrease 11: \*k1, K2tog\* (20sts in size L, or 14sts in size M).

Cut the thread to 30 cm in length, with a yarn needle pass this thread twice in all the stitches, tighten the top of the hat, return and bring in the thread, cut it short. Bring in and cut short the other threads.
